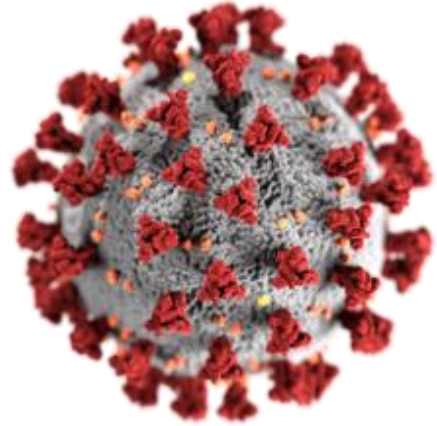


JULY 23, 2020 COVID-19 UPDATE

Effective July 27th, 2020 and for the foreseeable future, we will be taking these extra precautions to ward off Coronavirus. We have been privileged as a county to have a low rate of cases and DCA would like to be proactive in sustaining that.

Preventative Measures Include:

- **Adjusted Hours** from 7:00am-5:30pm
- **Staff** will be required to wear **masks**
