Magazines: Please bag with Books, Newspapers, Mixed Paper and Phone Books

Only slick or shiny magazines and catalogs accepted

Mixed Paper: Please bag with Books, Newspapers, Magazines and Phone Books

Acceptable

Envelopes
Light pastel colored paper
File folders
Unwanted residential mail

Phone Books: Please bag with Books, Newspapers, Magazines and Mixed Paper

DO NOT BUNDLE WITH PAPER PRODUCTS

Cardboard: Corrugated cardboard only. Please flatten and stack. Remove all food scraps

Acceptable

Packing Boxes with or without staples

Brown paper sacks

Cereal boxes and other food boxes

Tissue boxes (remove liners)

DO NOT BUNDLE WITH PAPER PRODUCTS

Plastic Bottles & Jugs: Check the bottom of the container for the recycling logo. Inside the logo is a number identifying the type of plastic. Generally, plastics accepted for recycling are #1 – #7.

Acceptable

Milk jugs, Juice jugs

Food containers

Detergent bottles

Shampoo bottles

Butter containers

Bleach jugs

Yogurt containers

Metal Cans: All tin and aluminum cans are acceptable. Rinse the can. Please remove the labels if possible. Crush the can or stack smaller ones inside larger cans. Place in designated container
