She often used several phrases. With these phrass, she vented her annoyance, her anger, and even her impatience. "I would like God to take me away," she sometimes said. "I wish the devil would take me," she would say on other occasions. "I would like the earth to swallow me," she used to say.

One day, Reneé Truta, thirty-seven years old from Constanza, Romania, wanted to photograph herself with a tornado behind her. Her husband appeased her and took the photo. Seconds later, the raging whirlwind lifted her into the air and carried her seven miles, dropping her onto the sandy bank of a river.

"I think the good Lord has something in mind for me," Reneé concluded after that experience.

That was an extraordinary case which occurred at the beginning of May in Romania. A tornado, in a raging storm, snatched that lady and carried her through the air. The lady survived the incident but lost an ear and broke an arm. She also lost forever the habit of venting her impatience with silly phrases. A violent tornado taught her a lesson.

Many times, it takes something violent - a storm, a terrifying earthquake, a fire, or a shipwreck - for the human being to think about life and decide to put it in order.

There are marriages that only when they suffer misfortune forget their disputes and begin to love each other again. There are families that only when they are struck by misfortune that they draw near to God. There are individuals for whom an illness, a serious accident, or a miraculous escape from death makes them retrace their steps and seek a new life.

In all these cases, in which a tragic experience leads the marriage, family, or individual, to find comfort or a higher strength, Jesus Christ is always close to them to help them. However, it is not necessary to suffer a tornado, a crash, a shipwreck, a calamity or a disaster, whatever it may be, to be reconciled to God, although it is true that all these things serve to make us reflect.

Christ is close to each of us, whether in full peace or amid a tragedy, we can cry out to Him and meet Him. Don't wait to something violent or tragic come to your life to shift what it need to be changed in your life, in your family or your marriage. Jesus alone is the solution and there is peace.
